



AUSTIN CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

- A. Applicant must be currently enrolled in (or have been accepted into) a construction related program at a school in the United States and must have at least one term remaining in a course of study leading to a certification or degree in a construction related field.
- B. Applicant must desire a career in a construction related field.
- C. Applicant must be enrolled full-time.
- D. Applicant must have a current cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher to be considered for awards.
- E. NAWIC members and their families are not eligible.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items listed below are submitted to the NAWIC Austin Chapter Scholarship Committee and received by **Friday, April 30, 2021**. Please attach as follows:

- A. Completed and signed application form.
- B. Transcript of grades for three most recent semesters.
- C. Financial need explanation (one-page limit).

AWARDS

- A. NAWIC Austin will award four Scholarships for the 2020-2021 Academic year.
One (1) **\$5,000**, One (1) **\$2,000**, Two (2) **\$1,000**
- B. Scholarships are not automatically renewed. Students will be considered for subsequent awards if they provide evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, continued enrollment, and good standing in a program leading to a certification of degree in a construction related field.
- C. The Austin NAWIC Scholarship Committee will review applications and select winners. The Committee will consider applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and financial need. The Committee will notify all applicants of their status no later than **May 28, 2021**.
- D. Applicants selected may be subject to a personal interview with a representative of the NAWIC Austin Scholarship Committee.
- E. Proof of matriculation for the next school term and other information as designated by the Committee must be received no later than **July 18, 2021**.
- F. Checks will be sent directly to the school's financial office in August preceding the school year. Distribution will be 50 % per semester. Student must maintain 2.75 GPA for the previous semester to remain eligible for the second 50% distribution.
